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REGULATIONS

on the organization and operation of the Compartment for the Liaison with the Preuniversity Environment

Chapter I. General provisions

Art. 1 The mission of the *Compartment for the Liaison with the Preuniversity Environment* is to promote the educational offer and to support/ strengthen the relationship with the preuniversity environment and educational partners.

Chapter II - Objectives and activities

Art. 2 The *Compartment for the Liaison with the Preuniversity Environment* (CRMP) has as its main objective the organization of activities to promote Transilvania University of Braşov in the preuniversity environment.

Activities:

- to promote the educational offer of Transilvania University of Braşov among high school pupils;
- to initiate activities to strengthen the relationship with the preuniversity environment (county school inspectorates, secondary education units, other partners);
- to organise activities in partnership with the University's faculties/ departments in order to strengthen the relationship with the preuniversity environment;
- to organise training sessions with each faculty's appointed officers for the promotion campaign of the study programmes;
- to conclude partnership agreements with the preuniversity institutions and other educational partners;
- to organise the high school pupils' visits to UNITBV;
- to initiate, conduct and participate in joint educational projects with the preuniversity environment;
- to conduct dropout reduction programmes at the preuniversity level, together with other institutions in the pre-university environment and with other educational partners;
- to participate in extracurricular educational activities together with the preuniversity institutions and with other educational partners.

Art. 3 CRMP ensures higher local and national visibility of Transilvania University of Braşov, according to its general strategy, to the specific requirements and decisions of the University Management, by:

- a) making and developing the promotion strategy of the educational offer within the preuniversity environment, in collaboration with the University's faculties, departments and support structures;
- contributing to the development and dissemination of materials to promote the University's educational offer;
- participating in the organization and smooth running of the events organised to promote the University's educational offer, coordinated by the University's representatives.

Chapter III - Organization and operation

Art. 4 (1) CRMP is a support structure organised within the University, subordinate to the Vice-Rectorate for Public Relations;

(2) CRMP is led by a coordinator, tenured teaching personnel member within the University, appointed by the Executive Board, and it includes administrative staff and the officers for promoting the University's educational offer;

(3) CRMP collaborates with the University's other vice-rectorates, research structures, support and technical-administrative structures, as well as with each faculty's appointed officers for the promotion campaign of the study programmes, in order to fulfill its mission, objectives and tasks;

(4) It ensures permanent information and fulfils the University Management's dispositions on the activity of CRMP;

(5) It makes proposals for the improvement of the procedures and working tools, with a view to reducing the costs;

(6) It attends educational fairs and other promotional events, it organises/ participates in visits to high schools, it plans/ organises events with the students and academic teaching personnel in order to promote the educational offer;

(7) It implements strategies and programmes for communication, creation and consolidation of the University's relationship with the preuniversity environment.

Chapter IV - Final provisions

Art. 5 The organizational structure (number and tasks of the positions) is established according to the internal regulations and to the legislation in force.
