Job-related skills

Among my main lines of research, the most relevant is the analysis of industrial clusters, studying the effect that variables such as Absorptive Capacity, Social Capital or Shared Vision have on the development of territorial innovation.

Since my doctoral dissertation, territorial factors, clusters and innovation have been present in my hypotheses. My contributions are related to the dynamics of development and innovation in companies located in clusters, also analysing the impact of links with local institutions. My empirical studies have been mainly related to sectors such as textiles, ceramics, toys and agri-food. These realities have been studied mainly in Spain, and more recently I have incorporated new international realities in my research thanks to the collaboration with professors from the University of Transylvania in Brasov (Romania).

In 2013 I received the Teaching Excellence Award from the Social Council and the Ministry of Education.

In terms of quality indicators, I have a total of 308 citations in WoS (H-index 12), 429 citations in Scopus (H-index 14) and 1,324 in Google Scholar (H-index 18).

Currently, I have published several papers indexed in top level ISI-JCR journals, where four of them are in international co-authorship with professors from Romania. I have also published several papers indexed in Scopus journals. I have presented 93 communications in conferences, some of them in international conferences (ERSA)

I have taken part in 22 research projects funded by different entities, such as the Spanish Ministry of Science and Innovation or other regional governments, leading 4 of them as main researcher, and I have also participated in 5 knowledge transfer contracts with institutions and companies.

Also, I have directed two doctoral theses and I'm currently directing 5, on industrial clusters, innovation and sustainability.

I coordinated the session "05-Glocal clusters: critical aspects and new trajectories" at the XLV International Conference on Regional Science, and I was editor of a special issue "Regional Clusters: Sailing Together towards a New Economy" in the journal Social Sciences (2019). I was also chair of the organising committee of the IV Jornades d'Economia Valenciana in 2019.

I have several research stays, having visited on three occasions the Universitatea Transilvania din Brasov.
